ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

Cf. Lumen gentium, 58

The Blessed Virgin Mary advanced in her pilgrimage of faith, and faithfully persevered in her union with her Son unto the cross.

Or: Cf. Mt 2:10-11

The magi were entering the house, and they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage.

The Gloria in excelsis (Glory to God in the highest) is said.

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.
